

The Erasmus+ e-VAL project : here we go!



On 16 and 17 February 2017, the University of Cadiz hosted the kick-off meeting of the Erasmus+ e-VAL project. The project that is funded with the support of the European Commission has as its main objective the implementation of the e-portfolio approach and a digital environment enabling Moroccan students to develop their digital visibility by capitalizing on their training outcomes and skills obtained during their studies and after graduation. The e-VAL platform is intended to be a tool for employability and vocational and professional development.

Alongside the University of Cadiz, the coordinator of the project and of Abdelmalek Essaâdi University, and the co-coordinator, thirteen other institutions and organizations were represented.

On the European side: University of Vigo, University of Porto, University of Bordeaux Montaigne, Vrije Universiteit Brussel and KTH University.

On the Moroccan side: The Ministry of Higher Education, Professional Training, and Scientific Research; the universities of Kenitra, Fez, Agadir, and Oujda; the International University of Rabat; the National Agency for the Promotion of Employment and Competences (ANAPEC) and the Association of Women Entrepreneurs of Morocco (AFEM).

For the period of three years, these partners will work together to develop the objectives of the e-VAL project.
