#### 2. Communication

During the activities at KTH on the territory of the KTH campus the wireless Internet access will be offered for the team members. Login credentials will be provided upon your arrival to KTH September 13.

### 3. Transportation

Upon arrival to Stockholm you are recommended to acquire a 1-week (alternatively 72 hours) transportation card.

The card is valid on all public transport in the Stockholm region including metro, busses, local trains and the boat connecting Slussen and Djurgården. 1-week validity is calculated from the time of the first use of the card.

The easiest way to reach KTH campus is to take metro red line towards Mörby Centrum. Upon arrival to the station Tekniska Högskolan you shall take the exit situated on the back of your train if you are coming from the city centre and in front of the train if you are coming from Mörby Centrum (the station has 2 exits) and then follow the signs towards Tekniska Högskolan. I attach the map of the university campus with the location of the venue of the

event – Brinellvägen 8 (look on the map for "KTH University Administration".
